Rehearsal Note

An SATB formation is recommended in order to facilitate spatialization effects, particularly in bitonal passages such as mm. 17-23 and mm. 37-41. The sopranos and altos often sing as a unit, and the tenors and basses as a different, overlapping unit. A mixed position will detract from the stereo image created between the two groups, as well as blur the occasional harmonic individuality of the two groups.

* Gradually change to the next phoneme in the given duration. An overtone sweep should result between vowels. It may be helpful to color the vowel transformation with [j] or [r] in order to create the overtone sweep. Only the tenors should linger on the goal phonemes and begin morphing vowels when each arrow starts. The sound should be continuously transforming for the sopranos and altos.
